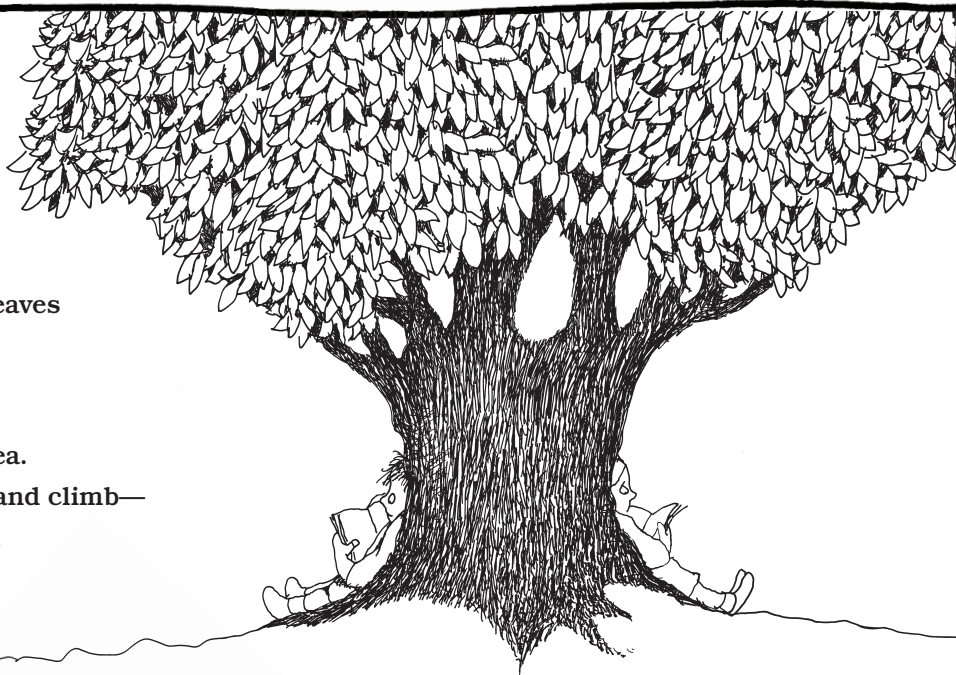


Come Sit Under the “Poet Tree” with Shel Silverstein!

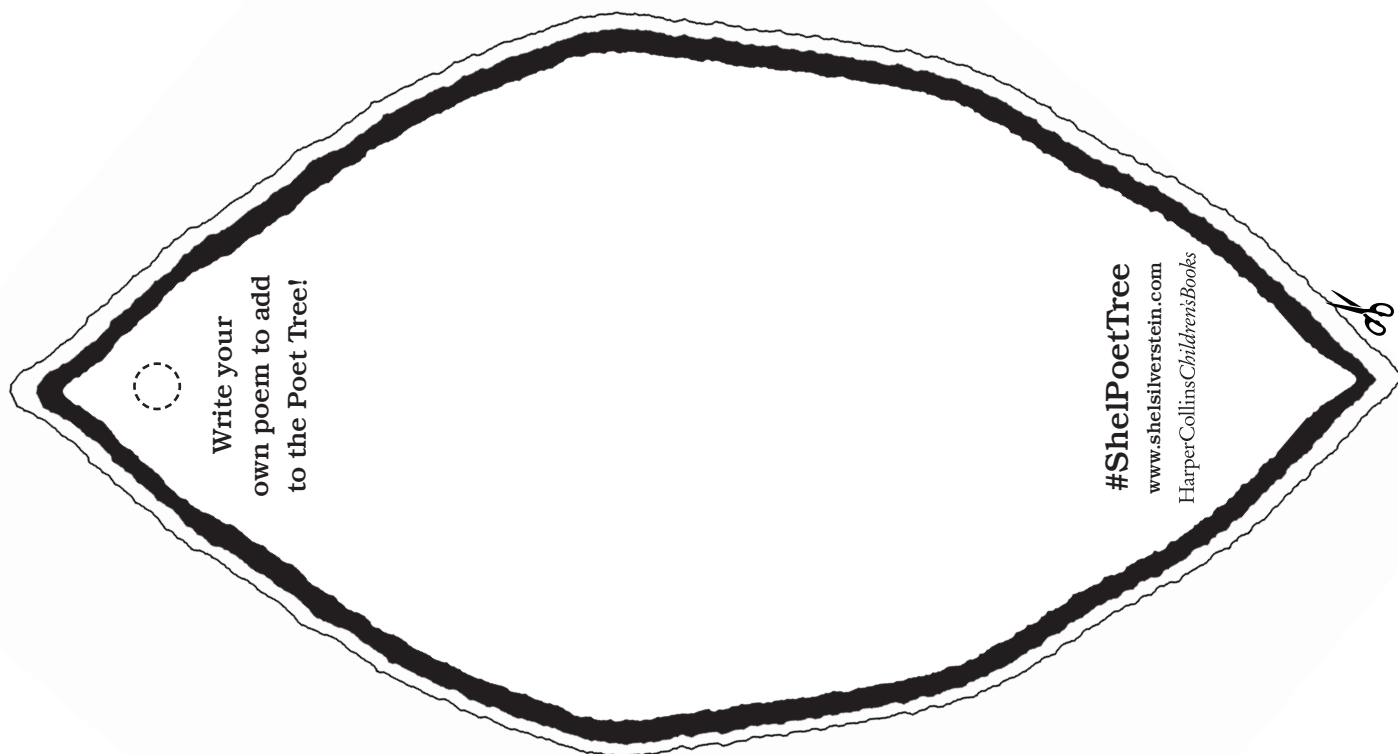
THE POET TREE
